

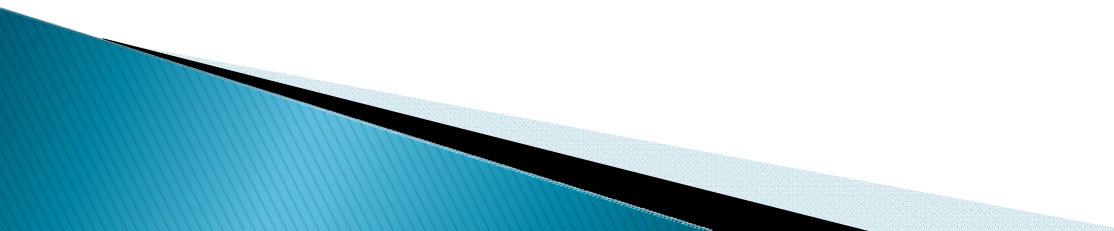

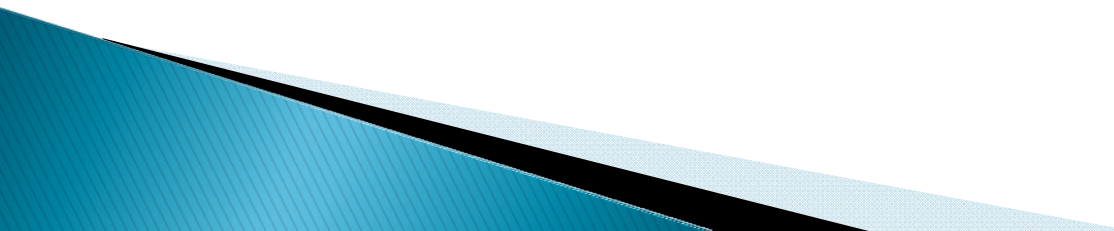
# Course Goal
